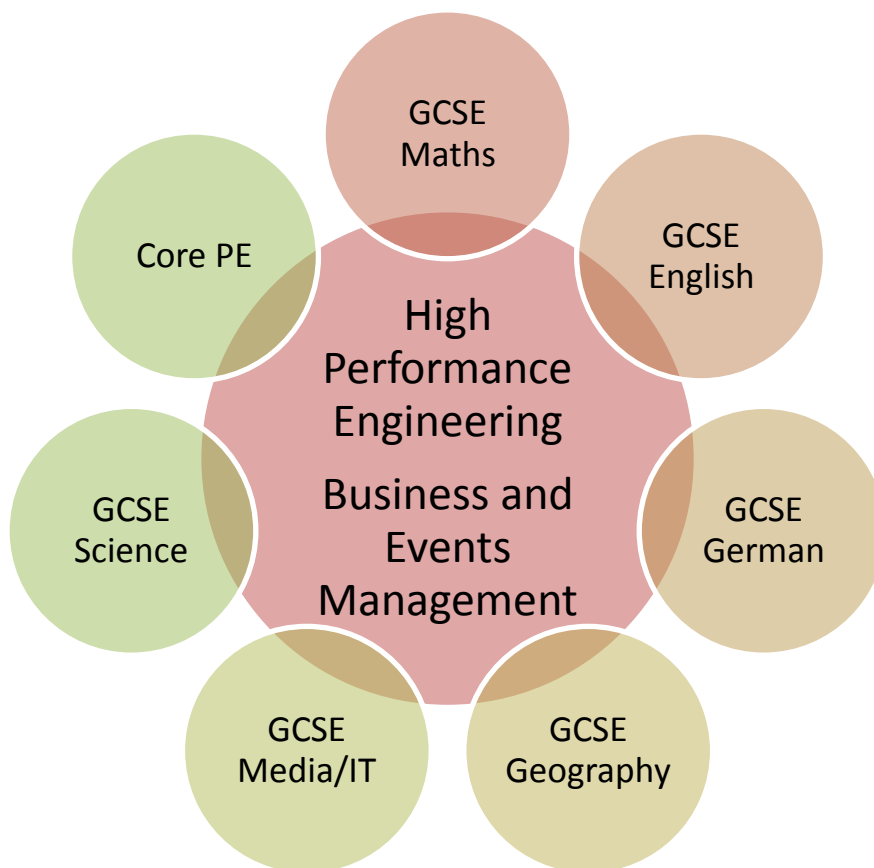


Silverstone UTC KS4 (14-16) Curriculum

Part 1 – The formal curriculum inspiring excellence in high performance engineering and business & technical events management.

Students entering Year 10 at Silverstone UTC choose their focus which is either Business & Technical Events Management or High Performance Engineering, all other subjects are compulsory.

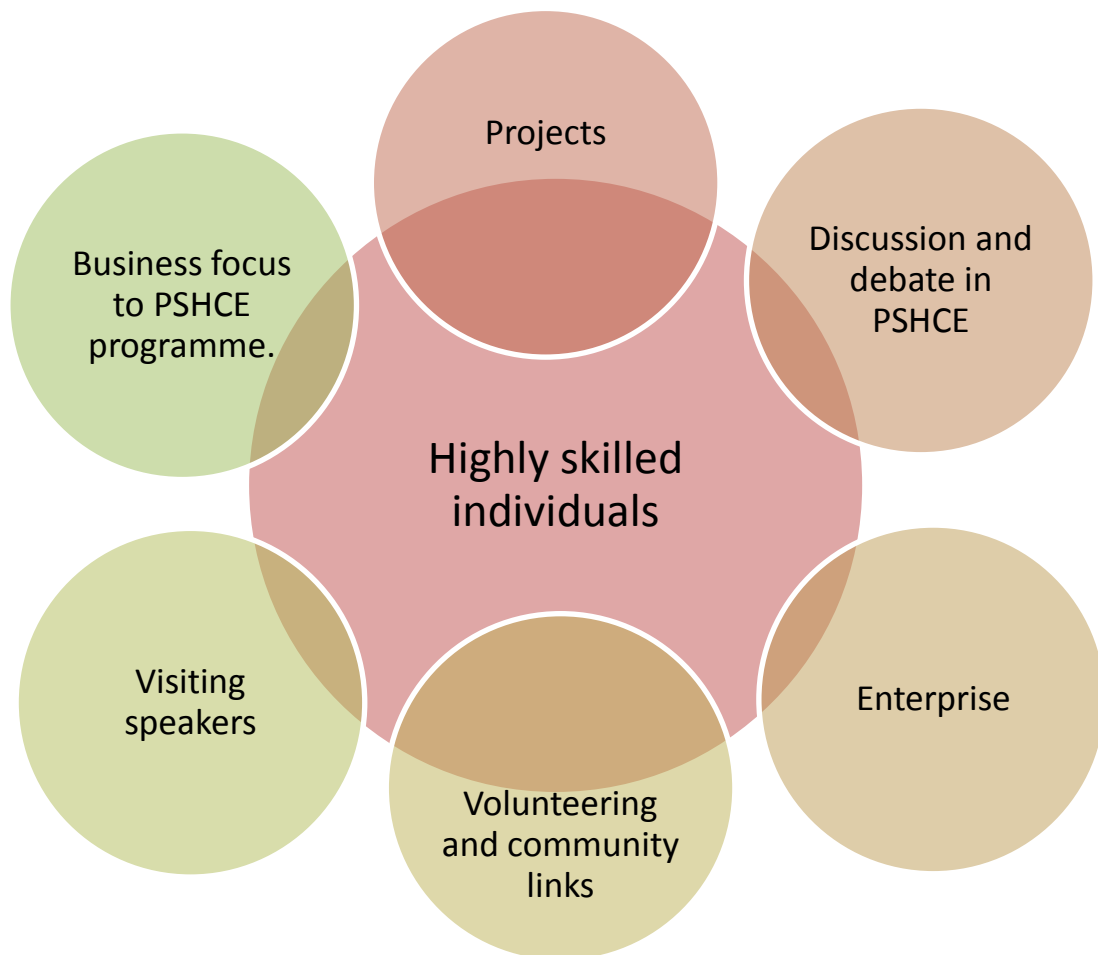


The students will spend a large proportion of their week focused on either high performance engineering (through OCR Principal Learning) or business and events management (through OCR Business).

Part 2 - Developing business and communication skills

Some of our students will work towards a HPQ, Higher level Project (level 2) to link their interests, skills and knowledge.
